Dear Chapter President:

Do you know about the fantastic Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Foundation Scholarships? They are awarded every year at the annual Houston Alumnae Panhellenic Association and Foundation luncheon, which this year will be held on May 5, 2022, in the Junior League of Houston ballroom.

Applications and information concerning HAPF scholarships are found online at the website www.houston-panhellenic.org/scholarships. The scholarships are awarded to young women, who graduated from a Harris County high school (or contiguous county high school).

Undergraduate students who are members of a National Panhellenic Conference sorority, who are full-time students (12 hours or more per semester as required by their college or university), and who will be enrolled for fall and spring semesters 2021-2022, are eligible. The scholarships are based on need and may be applied ONLY TO TUITION at their university. Those with a full tuition, scholarship, or grant are not eligible.

Please let your Alumnae groups, Mothers'/Parents' Clubs, and Collegiate Chapters know about these opportunities and encourage your members to support our efforts. More information will be shared with you at future HAPA meetings.

Some interesting statistics regarding HAPF scholarships:

- Since 1987: \$1,136,600.00 has been awarded to 624 deserving collegiate women from the Houston / Harris County area. In the past two years, \$153,000.00 was provided toward tuition expenses for these young women.
- In 2021: \$81,500.00 was awarded to thirty (30) outstanding collegiate women, representing fourteen (14) different sororities, and attending Texas and out-of-state universities.

As a HAPA delegate, you and your chapter President can encourage all qualified, active collegiate members to apply, and to **BEGIN EARLY** to acquire all of the required information. It takes longer than anticipated to obtain letters of recommendation from the chapter advisor and a selected professor, college transcripts, and to write a quality letter containing personal information to explain why the financial assistance is needed.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MIDNIGHT TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2022.
